FROM THE PRESIDENTS DESK

Hi everyone.

We trust you are all enjoying the cooler weather.

Well, July's CLASSIC QLD has been run. What a busy weekend at Qld Raceway.

On behalf of the Management Committee, I extend a warm thanks to the dozen or so volunteers who gave their time and efforts across the weekend. Sincere thanks also goes to Tony Quinn, Josh Macfarlane and the Qld Raceway team for their support and efforts across the weekend.

As it was Year 1 for CLASSIC QLD, the effort needed to get it off the ground was substantial. At least 7 months of solid work was needed. A good analogy would be trying to push start a train. Nothing happens for quite a while, then things start to move.

This first year had a simple objective - to demonstrate the merit and attraction of a large Queensland based 2 + 4 wheeled event, combining racing, static displays and other off-track interests.

Part of the attraction is the attendance of some extraordinary racing machinery. Without doubt, the quality of the bikes and cars that attended was exceptional.

Yes, the bike and car track numbers were lower for Year 1, however this was 100% OK and planned for. Some of the contributing factors were:

1. Cars? There had been 2 prior cancellations of HRCC events at QR in recent years which had people doubting our resolve this year.

2. Many other competitors and display entrants hadn't been to QR for many years, since before its refurbishment they needed to see the new setup.

3. Some people don't like the QR National circuit and maybe never will warm to the other smaller, tighter clubman or switchback circuits.

4. Bikes? The bike guys had other large events planned in Stanthorpe and elsewhere on the same weekend. Additionally, many of them needed convincing about the merits of a car/bike combined event.

For those that missed it, we had 145 people join us for Saturday's dinner. QR's

corporate room may be too small for Year 2, so we may relocate to the rooftop (with some braziers for warmth!)

We have eyes on year 2 to 5. At the heart of this event is the Spectators. There is nothing stopping us from having 10,000 people attending this meeting. We feel Queensland deserves a central Historic event on the National Motorsport Calendar. As THE custodians of Historics in Qld, the HRCC has a responsibility to nurture/grow the sport. In much the same vein as Winton Festival of Speed, Adelaide Festival of Speed and Phillip Island Classic, CLASSIC QLD can grow to become another must attend event.

Feedback:

We have sought event feedback from many people. 90% of feedback was overwhelmingly positive. Of course we have a number of areas to fine tune, which will occupy us in the planning process. We are already planning for next year's event, and we will be sending invites to certain racing groups so we can lock the program in early.

As an HRCC member - if you want this major national event, you had better support it!

SPRING CLASSIC SPEEDFEST

Next on the horizon is the Spring Classic Speedfest on 17-19 October. This will be at Morgan Park.

We will again have a Saturday night party with pizza, burgers, drinks, etc.. and live music. This will commence straight after racing. Weather permitting, this will be under the stars and not in that maintenance shed!

We purchased some great new club marquees and hope to setup the party under these.

Our Group N crew are featuring this weekend and will be on track in force.

Also, we are enjoying seeing the growing numbers in a number of our other groups.

The Invited sprint group has proven popular, with an increasing number of great cars joining our club and events. Regularity is also growing at a satisfying rate.

We do need to keep a focus on some of our open wheeler groups, which have languished somewhat in recent times.




