FURTHER SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS



The Event shall be a **National Historic Race Event** held under the current FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the current National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia, the Circuit Race Standing Regulations (CRSR), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, the Regulations for 5th Category Historic Cars, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Supplementary Regulations and or instructions issued for the Event. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with any or all of the current Motorsport Australia COVID-19 Return to Race strategy requirements at the time of this Event.

3. DOCUMENT CHECK SCHEDULE

Electronic Prior to event.

NOTE: A separate check of all documents may be done at any time during the course of the event.

NOTE: Please present if required: Motorsport Australia Licence, Motorsport Australia Competitor Activity Record Book, Motorsport Australia affiliated Club Membership Card, Motorsport Australia Vehicle Logbook & CTP Extension for Qld Road Registered Vehicles Competing.

4. SCRUTINY SCHEDULE

The Self-Scrutiny Checklist MUST be handed to the Scrutiny team.

Scrutineers will be checking vehicles through the course of the event.

NOTE: Target Scrutiny will be available / Scrutiny will be as per PA announcements.

5. LICENCE OBSERVATION

Drivers requiring observation please leave your Motorsport Australia OLT Form with Secretary of the Event prior to Qualifying, who will advise the Clerk of the Course of your name, car number and category. After qualifying take your time sheet to the Assistant Clerk of the Course in the bottom floor of the pit lane tower, so that your licence may be endorsed.

6. PROVISIONAL LICENCE HOLDERS

It is your responsibility to leave your licence with the Secretary of the Event at Prior to Qualifying, who will forward it to the Clerk of the Course for endorsement towards your Circuit licence.

7. GRID POSITIONS

Competitors are advised that grid positions for the first round of Scratch Races will be determined by qualifying times. Grid positions for subsequent Scratch Races will be determined by the finishing order of that group's previous Scratch Race.

8. START PROCEDURES

- a) The following Groups and Races will be **Rolling Starts**.
 - i. Heritage Touring Cars Groups C & A
 - ii. Historic Sports and Racing Cars Groups Q,RCars will assemble in the marshalling area in Grid Order and will move onto the circuit for one (1) formation lap during which **overtaking is prohibited**. Yellow flags will be shown at all Flag Posts until all vehicles have entered the Circuit at which point the Yellow Flags will be withdrawn. The start of the race will be signalled by the extinguishing of the Red Lights, a Green Flag may be shown. See Circuit Race Standing Regulations.
- b) **Standing Starts** All scratch races will assemble in the numbered bays in the marshalling area and will move onto the circuit for one (1) formation lap before taking up their allocated position for a massed grid start. The starter will indicate approximately 5 seconds before the red lights are switched on. At a time between 3 and 5 seconds after the red light is shown, the start of the race will be indicated by the extinguishment of the red lights. **A green light will not be shown.**
- c) **Regularity Events /**
 - i. When called, Cars will assemble in the Marshalling Area in order of fastest to slowest based on nominated times
 - ii. Prior to each Trial a 1 Minute Board will be shown
 - iii. Cars will then proceed single file onto the circuit as directed for a Warm-up lap. Overtaking is not permitted.
 - iv. Yellow flags will be displayed at all flag posts on the Warm-up lap until the Starter displays a Green Flag for a Flying Single File Start.
 - v. Timing will commence for each car as it crosses the Start / Finish line for the beginning of the trial and will continue until the prescribed number of laps are completed. The chequered flag will indicate the completion of the sprint.
- d) **Super Sprint / START PROCEDURE**
 - i. When called, Cars will assemble in the Marshalling Area in order of fastest time in practice to slowest
 - ii. Prior to each Sprint a 1 Minute Board will be shown
 - iii. Cars will then proceed single file onto the circuit at suitable intervals as directed for a Warm-up lap. Overtaking is not permitted and the release intervals must be maintained on the Warm-up lap.
 - iv. Yellow flags will be displayed at all flag posts on the Warm-up lap until the Starter displays a Green Flag for a Flying Single File Start.
 - v. Timing will commence for each car as it crosses the Start / Finish line for the beginning of the sprint and will continue until the prescribed number of laps are completed. The chequered flag will indicate the completion of the sprint.
 - vi. The starting order for the subsequent Sprint will be determined by the results of the preceding Sprint, quickest to slowest.

9. COMPULSORY DRIVERS BRIEFING (ALL DRIVERS)

A Compulsory Driver's Briefing will be held for **ALL DRIVERS** 7:50am. All drivers to assemble in the marshalling area.

Refer CSRs 9.3 Minimum Penalties for failing to attend and/or sign.

10. CODE OF DRIVING CONDUCT

Competitors are reminded of Article 1.3 of Events of the 5th Category Regulations and Article 7 of the Circuit Race Standing Regulations in the current Motorsport Australia Manual and should be aware the Clerk of the Course has the authority to impose a **pit lane drive through penalty** and or **time penalties** for any breaches.

11. COMPULSORY REPORTING Ontrack Incidents.

Any on-track incident resulting in vehicle damage **MUST** be reported to the Clerk of the Course, or their representative, by all drivers involved.

12. REGULARITY TIME NOMINATIONS

- i. A separate area (3 x 3 m marquee) near the Smoking area will be set up specifically for the Regularity Competitors to review and nominate times for their events. **(Please adhere to COVID Social Distancing Restrictions)**
- ii. A table will be setup with signage for Group 1 and Group 2 at different ends to view times and record new time for each run. Hand sanitiser provided at each end.
- iii. All competitors will be supplied with a pen for their personal use. Spare pens will be on the table and a container for after their use. (a system for cleaning has been developed).
- iv. Times for each event will be displayed on boards (please do not take these away)
- v. Markers for social distancing will be displayed

13. GENERAL

- i. All COMPETITORS in all CLASSES including Regularity are reminded that all HISTORIC CARS must comply with the provisions of Technical Appendix - **Schedule K (Markings on Automobiles) and Articles 1.3 and 1.4 of General Requirements of the 5th Category regulations** regarding advertising and competition numbers under the General Requirements in the Motorsport Australia Manual.

- ii. This Event may include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.
- iii. **Thursday May 6th 2021; The Precinct Gate will be LOCKED until 1:30pm.** Entry will not be permitted with the exception of those who have registered to help with the paddock setup
- iv. **STRICTLY NO SMOKING:** Morgan Park has a No Smoking Policy which must be adhered to. This covers the entire precinct with the exception of a designated, signed area. This area is near the precinct entry road adjacent to the Canteen.
- v. Morgan Park has a **NO OPEN FIRE** Policy. This is in place for the entire circuit precinct.
